The mission of the Women In Film & Television Mentor Program is to nurture emerging and existing talent in the entertainment industry by connecting individual WIFT members with established professionals in the industry. Mentees are paired with mentors according to career interest and compatibility.

The duration of the Program is six months. During that time, the mentor has a responsibility to meet with or talk to his/her mentee at least two times per month. The goal of this Program is **NOT** for the mentee to get a job – it is simply to make a contact in the industry and to get advice and guidance from an established professional in the mentee's field of interest.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Applications must be submitted to WIFT by the first weeks of December and June. No extensions will be given.

The WIFT Mentor Program will follow from January – June, and July – December. All applications will be reviewed by the WIFT Mentor Program Committee and the top 5 candidates will be interviewed by the Committee (and the mentors, if they choose). Interviews will take place in January and July, 2007.

The Program is very competitive and reserved for serious applicants only.
